Standard: Children demonstrate strength, coordination, and controlled use of large muscles.

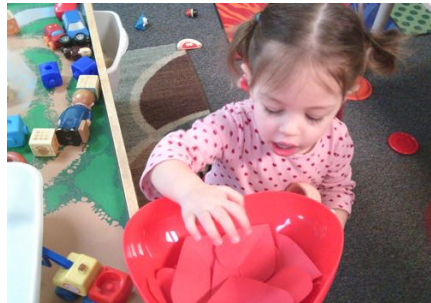


Here We Captured a Fun Moment in our Room. The Children Simply Started Playing and Singing and Soon Everyone Joined in on the Fun!
